The Honourable Mr. Justice D. Blair Mason
 Now a Justice of Court of Queen's Bench, Mr. Justice Mason was formerly a leading advocate in the expropriation area.

Edward J. Shaske
 One of the foremost Appraisers in Alberta, Mr. Shaske frequently appears as an expert witness before the Court of Queen's Bench, the Land Compensation Board, The Surface Rights Board, and other tribunals.

Clifford S. Watts
 Mr. Watts is Chief Legislative Counsel for the Province of British Columbia. He drafted the new B.C. Expropriation Act.

Dr. C. D. Stewart
 With an extensive and varied background in Agricultural and Water Resources Management in both the private and public sectors, Dr. Stewart is presently a key member of the Alberta Property Rights Association.

The Honourable Madame Justice M. Trussler
 Now a Judge on the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta, Madame Justice Trussler has an extensive background in the expropriation and surface rights area. She is a past member of the Alberta Land Compensation Board.
